

Dress Regulations

All members and their guests are expected to be appropriately dressed at all times.

IN THE CLUBHOUSE

Required/Allowed Smart casual dress (including smart denim trousers) at all times.
When collecting prizes on Presentation Nights, Jacket and Tie will be worn.
Tailored shorts. (There is no time limit on the wearing of shorts.)
Clean smart Training shoes.

Not Allowed Denim trousers with designer rips/tears
Track suits.
Football style shirts.
Shirts with slogans.
Golf shoes with studs.
Sandals without socks

ON THE COURSE

It is understood that clothing attire is constantly evolving and Members/Visitors are able to wear any recognised golf clothing which can be purchased at golf outlets and Pro's shops.

Required/Allowed Tailored trousers/slacks/skirts/shorts/skorts/kilts
Socks must be worn. (There is no specific design or colour)
Ladies ¾ length trousers
Shirts (with collars) to be tucked into trousers at all times.
Polo neck sweaters
Golf shoes

Not Allowed Denim jeans
T – Shirts without collars or sleeves
Football style shirts
Shirts with slogans
Sports shorts
Track Suits
Training shoes
Sweaters worn without shirts (except polo necks)

Enforcement
